

FEBRUARY STAMP CLASS TUTORIAL

CARD 1: LOVELY DAY CARD



SUPPLIES:

Stamps: Flowers of Beauty Stamps (also part of a Die

Bundle)

<u>Autumn Expressions Stamps</u> "Last Chance List" (also

part of a **Die Bundle**)

Ink Pads: Gorgeous Grape ink pad

Crushed Curry ink pad

Memento Tuxedo Black ink pad

Cardstock: Crushed Curry cardstock

Basic White cardstock

Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine: Plaster Painting

3D Embossing Folder

Embellishments: Gold Textured Adhesive Backed

Dots

Adhesives: Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue

INSTRUCTIONS:

1-Cut Your Papers:

~Crushed Curry Card Base: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and

fold at 4-1/4".

~Basic White Card Front: 3-3/4" x 5-1/4"

2-Stamping:

- ~Lay your Word Stamp and your Flower Stamp next to each other to determine the position of each.
- ~Stamp your center Flower first with Gorgeous Grape ink. Then stamp one Flower above and one below your center Flower.
- ~Your Flower Centers will be stamped with Crushed Curry ink. The stamp is larger than the white space available.
- ~Stamp your Words with Memento Black ink.

3-Finish Your Card:

- ~Put your Card Front in the Embossing Folder where you want it. Run through your Machine to emboss it.
- ~Glue your Card Front to your Card Base.
- ~Add three Gold Textured Dots where you want them. Your Card is finished.

CARD 2: JUST A NOTE HEART CARD

Ink Pad: Real Red ink pad Poppy Parade ink pad

Cardstock: Pretty in Pink cardstock

Basic White cardstock

Marbled Elegance 12x12 Specialty Designer Series

Paper (DSP)

Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine: Friends for Life

Dies (also part of a **Bundle**)

Adhesives: Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue

Stampin' Dimensionals

Mini Stampin' Dimensionals

Tear & Tape

Adhesive Sheets

Glue Dots

INSTRUCTIONS:

1-Cut Your Papers:

- ~Pretty in Pink Card Base: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".
- ~DSP Print: 4" x 5"
- ~Basic White Layer: 3" x 4"

2-White Layer Angle:

- ~Basic White Layer Angle: Mark with a pencil
- -Left Side: 1-1/8" from the bottom
- -Right Side: Mark with a Pencil 2-3/4" from the bottom
- ~Put in your Paper Trimmer and line up the Marks with the cutting groove. Cut your angle.

3-Stamp on your White Layer:

~Words: Real Red ink

~Hearts: Poppy Parade ink

4-Finish Your Card:

- ~Cut 1/4" off one side of your DSP Print. This is used between the DSP and the White Layers.
- ~Cut your Heart from Pretty in Pink cardstock. If desired, put an Adhesive Sheet on the back of your cardstock BEFORE cutting to make attaching it easier.
- ~Glue your White Layer to the Bottom of your DSP Print lining up the bottom and sides. Trim off excess if needed.
- ~Glue your 1/4" DSP Strip against your White Layer.
- ~Attach your Heart with either Glue or by peeling off the Adhesive Sheet backing.

Your Card is finished.

CARD 3: YOU MAKE ME SMILE CARD



SUPPLIES:

Bundle: Hugs for Love Stamps + To The Point Label

Punch

Stamps: <u>Bright Borders Stamps</u>
Ink Pad: <u>Shy Shamrock ink pad</u>

Berry Burst ink pad (or Petunia Pop ink pad)

Cardstock: Petunia Pop cardstock

Basic White cardstock

Unbounded Beauty 12x12 Designer Series Paper

<u>(DSP)</u>

Punch: To The Point Label Punch (part of Bundle above)

Ribbon: Iridescent 1/2" Striped Trim

Embellishments: <u>Sunny Days Iridescent Dots</u> **Adhesives:** <u>Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue</u>

Stampin' Dimensionals

Tear & Tape Glue Dots

INSTRUCTIONS:

1-Cut Your Papers:

~Petunia Pop Card Base: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".

~DSP Print: 4" x 5-1/4"

~Petunia Pop Strip: 3/4" x 4"

2-Label:

~Border: Stamp Border image on Basic White cardstock

with either Berry Burst or Petunia Pop ink. Mine is in Berry Burst ink. I wish I had used Petunia Pop ink.

- ~Stamp your Words inside your Border with Shy Shamrock ink.
- ~Punch out with the To The Point Punch.
- ~Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back.

3-Ribbon:


- ~Lay your Label and Petunia Pop Strip where you want them on your DSP Print.
- ~Glue on your Petunia Pop Strip.
- ~Put Tear & Tape on the back of your DSP Print behind your Petunia Pop Strip.
- ~Wrap your Ribbon around your Petunia Pop Strip. Tie a knot.
- ~Slide your Ribbon down some.
- ~Remove the Tear & Tape backing.
- ~Slide your Ribbon over the Tape.
- ~Press the Ribbon so it sticks to the Tape.
- ~Put a Glue Dot under the knot to hold it in place.

4-Finish Your Card:

- ~Glue your DSP Print to your Card Base.
- ~Attach your Label with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- ~Add three Sunny Day Dots.

Your Card is finished.

CARD 4: PINK FLOWERS & STRIPES CARD

Stamps: Crafting With You Stamps (also has

coordinating Dies) **Bright Borders Stamps**

Ink Pad: Berry Burst ink pad Cardstock: Berry Burst cardstock

Basic White cardstock **Bubble Bath cardstock**

Tools: Paper Snips Scissors
Adhesives: Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue

Tear & Tape

Stampin' DimensionalsGlue Dots

INSTRUCTIONS:

1-Cut Your Papers:

~Bubble Bath Card Base: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4"

~Basic White Card Front: 3-1/2" x 4-3/4"

~Berry Burst Layer: 3-5/8" x 3-7/8"

~DSP Prints: 1-1/2" x 6". Cut into three 1/2" x 6" strips

2-Card Front Strips:

~Your DSP Strips will be at a diagonal. Measure from the bottom Left: 2-1/4". From the bottom Right: 3-1/2".

~Put Tear & Tape between these two marks and around the lower sides and bottom. Add another strip of Tape in the center of this area.

~Lay out your DSP Strips in the pattern you want.

~Attach to your Tear & Tape starting at the top of the Tape. Make sure the cardstock is completely covered. We will trim off the excess later.

~Attach your Strips until the lower part of your Card Front is covered. There may be a small area not covered

~Turn your Card Front over so you can only see the part of the Strips sticking out.

~Trim off the Strips with your Paper Snips scissors that are hanging over the edge.

~Use the scraps to cover any White left on your Card Front and trim off the excess.

3-Flower:

~Cut one or two Flowers from Bubble Bath cardstock.

~Use Berry Burst cardstock to die cut the Flower Center.

~Layer the Flower pieces how you want them and glue together.

~Glue your Flower Center to the middle of your Flower.

~Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of your Flower.

4-Finish Your Card:

~Stamp Small Flowers with Berry Burst ink part way on the Right Side and Bottom of your Card.

~Lay your Flower and Word Stamp on your Card Front to decide where you Stamp your Words.

~Use Berry Burst ink to stamp your Words on your Card Front above your DSP Strips.

~Attach your Flower to your Card Front with Stampin' Dimensionals.

~Glue your Card Front to your Berry Burst Layer. Glue to your Card Base.

Your Pink Flower and Stripes Card is finished.
